Improve your Networking Skills-Top 10 Steps to Follow Up

- 1. **Follow up**. Do it within 24 hours. Find out how you can help your contact. Meet for coffee within a week.
- 2. **Take notes**. Write on their business card that you received write brief notes about the person you spoke to and what you talked about.
- 3. **Connect**. Email is how we all do business. (KISS) LinkedIn is your professional reputation. When you send a request to connect, remind the person who you are and how you met. It's good to be social.
- 4. **Use your calendar.** Use your calendar to set up a follow up or use your CRM system.
- 5. **Keep it short.** Keep your message short and to the point. Ask how you can help them?
- 6. **Host an event**. Schedule a meet up with a few clients and invite to make a deeper connection.
- 7. **Send a note.** "Congratulations on your grand opening, or Congratulations on the award! Best wishes for your continued success!"
