- State Parks - website: michigan.gov/dnr
 - water, electric, dump stations
 - modern bath facilities
 - 100% rustic with only what you bring in
 - activities usually include nature walks/hikes, water-fishing, boating, swimming
- Chain campgrounds - KOA for example website: KOA.com
 - any one you go to has many of the same amenities
 - more scheduled activities
 - typically in less rustic settings
- Independent Campgrounds - marvac.org
 - a wide variety of offerings, I like to say something for everyone:)
 - some allow tents some do not; some have age limits on camping units; some have lots of scheduled activities; some are really just a place to park, hook up and relax; some have full hook ups some do not
- Marvac.org is the place to go for all things camping in Michigan - Michigan Association of Recreational Vehicles and Campgrounds - you can find us there too, RV service/suppliers
- Local businesses allow camping- harvesthosts.com
 - pay for an annual membership
 - you are asked to spend about \$30 at each location and the locations range from farms, wineries, drive-in theaters, peoples driveways, museums, churches...
 - An amazing way to meet new people. You must have a self contained camping unit to take advantage of these
- Membership campgrounds - Outdoor adventures, waldenwoods
 - only members are allowed
 - pay an upfront buy in fee plus monthly maintenance fees
 - usually have lots of planned activities, pools, lazy rivers, mini golf
