 - -modern bath facilities
 - -100% rustic with only what you bring in
 - -activities usually include nature walks/hikes, water-fighing, boating, swimming
- -Chain campgrounds KOA for example website: KOA.com
 - -any one you go to has many of the same amenities
 - -more scheduled activities
 - -typically in less rustic settings

- some allow tents some do not; some have age limits on camping units; some have lots of scheduled activities; some are really just a place to park, hook up and relax; some have full hook ups some do not
